CAMPS, SPORTS AND EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF) 2019:

The State Government will be again providing funding for students, for camps, sports and excursions. To be eligible a parent or legal guardian of a student must hold a current Centrelink Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card.

**Eligibility Date:** 

The parent's or legal guardian's Concession Card must be valid with Centrelink on the first day of either Term One (29 January 2019) or Term Two (23 April 2019).

The payment amount for a primary school student is \$125.00 per year which is paid directly to the school. The amount is credited to excursions.

Processing of Application Forms (blank Application Form attached) will commence on 31<sup>st</sup> January 2019. Funding closes on 28 June 2019.

## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities. It is part of making Victoria the Education State and the Government's commitment to breaking the link between a student's background and their outcomes.

#### CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoom, excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works and sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-texted concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSUF. A special consideration category also exists for anyium seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to campa, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

#### The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- \$125 for primary school students.
- \$225 for secondary school students

#### HOW TO APPLY

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from www.education.vic.gov.su/csef

If you applied for the CSEF at your child's school in 2018, you do not need to complete an application form in 2019 unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- new student enrolments; your child has started or changed schools in 2019 or you did not apply in 2018.
- changed family circumstances; such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing at the school in 2019.

Check with the school office if you are unsure.

#### **CSEF ELIGIBILITY**

Below is the criteria used to determine a student's eligibility for the Campa, Sports and Excunsions Fund (CSEF).

#### Criteria 1 - Eligibility

EDUCATION

To be eligible\* for the fund, a parent or legal guardian of a student attending a registered Government or nongovernment Victorian primary or secondary school must:

- on the first day of Term one, or;
- on the first day of Term two;
  - a) Be an eligible beneficiary within the meaning of the State Concessions Act 2004, that is, be a holder of Veterans Affairs Gold Card or be an eligible Centrelink Health Care Card (HCC) or Pensioner Concession Card (PCC) holder, OR
  - b) Be a temporary foster parent, and
  - c) Submit an application to the school by the due date.

\*A special consideration eligibility category also exists. For more information, see: www.education.vic.gov.eu/csef

Parents who receive a Carer Allowance on behalf of a child, or any other benefit or allowance not income tested by Centrelink, are not eligible for the CSEF unless they also comply with one of (a) or (b) above.

#### Criteria 2 - Be of school age and attend school in Victoria

School is compulsory for all Victorian children aged between six and 17 years of age inclusive.

For the purposes of CSEF, students may be eligible for assistance if they attend a Victorian registered primary or secondary school. Typically, these students are aged between five and 18 years inclusive.

CSEF is not psysble to students attending pre-school, kindergarten, home schooled, or TAFE.

#### **Eligibility Date**

For concession card holders CSEF eligibility will be subject to the parent/legal guardian's concession card being successfully validated with Centralink on the first day of either term one (29 January 2019) or term two (23 April 2019).

#### PAYMENT AMOUNTS

#### **CSEF** payment amount

The CSEF is an annual payment to the achool to be used towards camps, sports and/or excursion expenses for the benefit of the eligible student.

- Primary school student rate: \$125 per year.
- Secondary school student rate: \$225 per year.

The CSEF is paid directly to your child's action and will be allocated by the school towards campa, aports and/or excursion costs for your child.

For ungraded students, the rate payable is determined by the student's date of birth. For more information, see, www.education.vic.gov.au/csef

Year 7 government school students who are CSEF recipients are also eligible for a uniform voucher. Secondary schools are required to make applications on behalf of parents so please register your interest at the school.

#### HOW TO COMPLETE THE APPLICATION FORM

NOTE: ALL SECTIONS MUST BE COMPLETED BY PARENTILEGAL GUARDIAN

- 1. Complete the PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN DETAILS section.
- Make sure that the Sumame, First Name, and Customer Reference Number (CRN) details match those on your concession card. You will also need to provide your concession card to the school.

If you are claiming as a Foster Parent or a Veteran Affairs Pensioner, you will need to provide a copy of documentation confirming your status as a temporary Foster Parent or provide your Veterans Affairs Pensioner Gold card to the school.

2. Complete the STUDENT/S DETAILS section for students at this school.

 Sign and date the form and return it to the school office as scon as possible. The CBEF program for 2019 closes on 28 June, 2019.

CSEF payments cannot be claimed retrospectively for prior years.

Queries relating to CSEF eligibility and payments should be directed to the school.
