Dear Community,

This Saturday June 15, our Year 3 students will receive their First Holy Communion.

This will be the first time they receive Jesus in the Blessed Eucharist, to nourish them as Catholics, as they continue on their faith journey. This journey, commenced at their Baptism and will continue sacramentally on Saturday, as they accept Jesus in the Eucharist, nourishing them and their faith, as well as each time they receive Him at Mass, after their First Communion.

The Eucharist is celebrated as a 'meal', just as Jesus gave Himself to His closest friends, the apostles, at a meal around a table, at a meal, over 2000 years ago. In giving Himself to the apostles in that meal, the Last Supper, he asked them to, "Do this in memory of me". And so we continue all these years later, to do as He asked His friends to do, to "take and eat", to "take and drink" and to "do it memory of Him".

We gather around a table - the altar; we listen to stories - the readings from the bible; we pray for one another & our world - the Prayers of the Faithful; we offer & share food - the blest bread & wine, which become Jesus' body & blood; and, we go out, nourished with the 'Bread of Life' - to live as Jesus asked us to live, loving one another, as we would have them love us. This is our Mass, this is the Eucharist and this is what sustains & supports us in our faith as Catholics.



Please keep our young Year 3 friends in your thoughts & prayers, this Saturday at 2.00 pm, as they take yet another momentous step in their faith journey.

#### **CAR PARK – DOUBLE PARKING**

Parents, guardians & grandparents, using the car park, are asked to <u>NOT DOUBLE PARK</u>, either before school, when dropping off in the morning but most particularly, in the afternoons, at pick up time. Double parking is a dangerous practice, as it places children & adults in danger of being hit by drivers, trying to get around cars illegally parked. Double parking also causes major traffic jamming, because vehicles are unable to get through the car park, due to double parked vehicles blocking the flow of traffic in and out of the car park.



#### **PREP & YEAR 1 - MARKET FRESH INCURSION**

On Tuesday, the Prep and Grade One students participated in a Market Fresh incursion. We learnt about different farms and how fruits and vegetables come from the farm to the fruit shop. The ladies also taught us about vitamins and where we should keep our apples and tomatoes to keep them fresh! It was very interesting, but our favourite part was when we tasted different fruits and vegetables! We tried apples, oranges, watermelons, mandarins, bananas, capsicums, cucumbers, tomatoes and avocado dip! It was healthy and delicious!

#### **2020 FOUNDATION (PREP) STUDENTS – ENROLMENT INTERVIEWS**

Enrolment Interviews for new families who have applied to enrol their children for Foundation (Prep) in 2020, have been conducted. Interviews with existing families will be conducted in the first half of Term 3. To ensure that we set aside a place for any of our existing families, who have a child eligible to enrol next year, we ask that you contact the school office, to obtain an Enrolment Application form. We would appreciate you completing the application and returning it to the School office, as soon as possible.

#### SECONDARY COLLEGE ENROLMENTS

Parents & guardians of students in Years 4, 5 & 6 are reminded that considerable thought & planning need to be undertaken in selecting & applying for enrolment in Catholic, independent & state secondary colleges. It is too late to leave your thinking, choosing & applying until Grade 6, as most secondary colleges are accepting applications as early as Grade 4.

#### SCHOOL UNIFORMS

All students should be in their winter uniforms by now (Terms 2 & 3). Just a reminder to all parents (especially our new Prep Families) that the Uniform shop is open on Friday mornings, from 8.30 am to 9.30 am for purchases, trying sizes and to place orders. #### **STUDENT LUNCH BAGS / BOXES & UNIFORM ITEMS**

A reminder to parents & guardians, to please label your children's lunch bags or boxes and uniform items. Many recently have been misplaced, lost, handed in or found their way into the lost property without names; this makes it difficult to return these items to your child.

#### STUDENT LATE ARRIVALS

If your child arrives at school after the second bell at 9.00 am, please make sure you and your child/children come firstly to the office and not directly to class, to be signed in and receive a Late Pass, to be handed to their class teacher.

#### **ABSENCE NOTIFICATIONS & UNEXPLAINED STUDENT ABSENCES**

If children are absent from school for any reason, **Parents or Guardians must notify the school** due to Child Safety Unexplained Student Absence laws, for:

\* extended holidays, outside of normal holiday periods, in writing, via the Skoolbag App, a form at the office, letter or email. Please provide your child's name, grade, first date not attending school and date returning to school. If travelling overseas please also include the country visiting. (School must be notified prior to leaving).

\* other reasons: illness/sick, medical appointments, personal, family or other reasons, please advise via the Skoolbag App, a phone call, verbally to office staff or class teachers, email or letter.

Please provide your child's name, grade, reason and time of absence. (School must be notified prior, by or on the day of absence before 9.30am).

If we do not receive any notification, office staff shall be obliged to ring either parent/guardian on mobile, home number or at work. If we are unable to make contact, then we will call the Emergency contacts you have provided. *If we are unable to make contact with parents, guardians or emergency contacts,*


#### **PARENTS GROUP: NEXT METINGS & TERM 2 EVENTS**


