POSSIBLE CAR PARK CLOSURE

Please do not double park in the car park at drop off or pick up time. This practice causes vehicles to backup out on to Sunshine Avenue, as well being dangerous for pedestrians (parents, guardians & children) walking through the car park. If a parking bay is not available, please continue through the car park, park on surrounding streets and walk in to collect your children. *If this and other dangerous driving practices continue and drivers continue to ignore the safety of pedestrians, the school will have no other option than to close the car park.* The school has no obligation to provide onsite parking; it is privilege and convenience which we are fortunate enough to have.

SUMMER UNIFORM

In Term 1 & Term 4, all students are expected to be in their summer uniform, consisting of the following:

- Girls: summer dress (school design); jumper (charcoal with embroidered crest); socks (white); school shoes (black); hat (slouch with embroidered crest)
 - Boys: shorts (grey with longer leg); shirt (short sleeved with embroidered crest); jumper (charcoal

As a SunSmart School, St. Paul's expectation is that students and staff wear hats at all times when outside, most particularly in Terms 1 & 4. Students must wear the school slouch / broad-brimmed hat, with the embroidered school crest; this style of hat ensures neck, ears and face are fully protected from the sun.
