Dear Community,

As the weather warms up – 33 degrees today – I ask that you ensure your children are in their summer uniform, most particularly their broad-brimmed school hat.

St. Paul's Primary School is a SunSmart School and as such we are constantly encouraging our students (and their families) to be aware of the deadly results that constant exposure to the sun can have.

As a SunSmart School we operate a 'No Hat No Play' rule, which requires children who do not have a hat to wear during outside play, to remain in the shade (under verandahs or shade sails) during lunch and recess breaks.

We ask parents & guardians to support our insistence on hats and the summer uniform, in the interest of their children's health & wellbeing. We also encourage the morning application of a high factor sunscreen (30+).

Melanoma skin cancer was the fourth most commonly diagnosed cancer in Australia in 2015. It is estimated that it will remain the fourth most commonly diagnosed cancer in 2019. In 2017, more than 1,800 Australians died from melanoma: that is five people each day. One person every five hours will die from melanoma in Australia.

In 2015, there were 13,694 new cases of melanoma skin cancer diagnosed in Australia (7,990 males and 5,704 females). In 2019, it is estimated that 15,229 new cases of melanoma skin cancer will be diagnosed in Australia (8,899 males and 6,330 females). In 2019, it is estimated that the risk of an individual being diagnosed with melanoma skin cancer by their 85th birthday will be 1 in 17 (1 in 13 males and 1 in 21 females).



Please do not allow your child to be counted among these shocking statistics – download the SunSmart App. and be sure your child has sun protection every day (sunscreen, broad-brimmed hat and minimal sun exposure).

### **2020 FEE & LEVIES SCHEDULE – EXPLANATION & BREAKDOWN**

I write to you to inform you of our 2020 fees and to explain payment methods, so that there is no confusion. The statement which you will receive at the beginning of the 2020 school year will be the **FULL** amount for fees, levies and camp (where applicable) due for the entire year.

There has been an increase in 2019 school fees and levies, as per my letter of explanation dated 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018. Every effort has been made to keep these increases to a minimum. The following explains

all areas of fees and levies at St Paul's Primary School. Fee collection is how we continue to provide a rich and

well-resourced education and school facility for your children.

We have provided a number of options to meet the needs of our families; these are listed on page two.

• If you commit to a Direct Debit, Credit Card or Centrepay Agreement,

<u>YOUR PAYEMENT OF FEES, LEVIES AND CAMP FEES ARE INCLUDED AS PART OF THIS AGREEMENT AND</u> <u>THE AGREEMENT WILL BE VALID UNTIL YOU WITHDRAW IT.</u>

- If you choose to pay in person at the office and not commit to any agreement the:
  - CURRICULUM-I.C.T. LEVY: IS TO BE PAID IN FULL BY THE END OF FEBRUARY EACH YEAR
  - FEES: <u>ARE TO BE PAID IN FULL BY 11<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER 2020</u>
  - CAMP FEE: IS TO BE PAID IN FULL 2 WEEKS PRIOR TO CHILD ATTENDING CAMP

**Excursion/Sports and Curriculum-I.C.T. Levy**: these levies pay for work books, excursions, stationery, library books,

I.C.T. resources and all the resources needed to educate your child. As from 2013 the Curriculum Levy has included all necessary stationery items which your children will need for the entire school year; you are not required to purchase any stationery items for your child. These items will be distributed to the children by the classroom teachers.

<u>School Fees</u>: are based on a Family Fee and not attributed to individual children. These fees pay for the running costs of a school, such as insurance, maintenance, power, gas, water and so on. These fees are, in fact, due and payable at the start of the school year. As you would no doubt be aware, many other schools ensure this happens. However, I am mindful that this, in many cases, is simply impossible. Therefore, agreements can be entered into to which suit the needs of your family and ensure that the **account is paid in full by 11<sup>th</sup> September 2020.** 

<u>Camp Fees</u>: will be invoiced to families with students in Grades 4, 5 and 6 and are payable 14 days prior to the child attending camp, unless you have a Direct Debit, Credit Card or Centrepay Agreement.

We have made every effort to keep costs to a minimum and still provide a rich, relevant and well-resourced education for your children.

If you are experiencing any difficulties please remember to come and speak to me as early as possible; together we will work out appropriate alternatives.
