
I share with you below, some words of comfort and reflection, which I shared yesterday with the staff, as we all live with the challenges of this time in our world ...

There is a 10 day ordering period if you wish to receive free delivery back to the school. This ordering window closes on 27th March 2020.

After this time, there will be a \$4.95 postage and handling fee on all orders, as they will be sent directly to your nominated address.
